SCHOLARSHIP PURPOSE: Academic Scholarship Program C is to encourage good distance learning college students to study the fields of logistics, transportation, supply chain, physical distribution, and passenger travel services.

I. Eligibility

1. Applicant must be a member of NDTA or a dependent of an NDTA member in good standing.

II. Requirements

1. At the time of filing his/her application, the student must be enrolled in a regionally accredited college or university.
2. The regionally accredited distance learning college/university which the applicant attends, must offer a minimum of 15 semester hours (or equivalent quarter hours) in logistics, transportation, supply chain, physical distribution or passenger travel services or some combination thereof.
3. The applicant must indicate on his/her application the logistics, transportation, supply chain, physical distribution or passenger travel services courses, he/she plans to incorporate into his/her degree program. These courses must comprise at least 15 semester hours (or quarter hour equivalent) of the student's required hours for a degree.
4. Scholarships are limited to those seeking an undergraduate degree.
5. Applicant must complete a minimum of 12 credit hours within a 12 month period.
6. Applicant must have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or the equivalent in other grading systems.
7. Applicant must provide a brief (300-500 word) essay outlining how the course of studies will assist in meeting the applicant's career goals.
8. Application must be accompanied by no more than three letters of recommendation from professors, mentors, pastors or other people who are not related to the applicant and can attest to the applicant's character, work habits and accomplishments.

III. Application Procedures

1. Blank application forms may be obtained by the NDTA member from:

 - c. The local Chapter, and

2. Annual renewal - requires new application with updated transcripts.
3. Completed applications must be submitted to the Forum, Education and Professional Development Committee postmarked no later than April 16th, or they may be emailed to mark@ndtahq.com subject: Scholarship Application. Scholarships will be effective with the fall term or a semester of that year.
4. The Forum, Education and Professional Development Committee will select scholarship recipients based upon the merit of each applicant, as attested to by academic performance and extracurricular involvement in school and community life.
