

## **LISA A. ROBERTS**



Lisa Roberts is the Acting, Assistant Deputy Under Secretary of Defense for Transportation Policy in the Office of the Secretary of Defense. She is responsible for the development of policies in support of DoD strategic distribution, traffic management, and transportation systems.

Prior to assuming her current position, Ms. Roberts served on the Headquarters, U.S. Army staff from 1995 to 2000. She was a Deputy Project Manager for the Deputy Secretary of Defense initiative to reengineer personal property processes. From 1992 to 1995, Ms. Roberts was a traffic management specialist assigned to the U.S. Army in Germany where she managed the Army's program to consolidate numerous transportation offices into one. She also served as the lead logistics coordinator and implemented an operational plan to close the Frankfurt Area Support Group and to relocate Headquarters V Corps.

From 1989 through 1992, Ms. Roberts held numerous transportation positions with the U.S. Air Force while completing an Air Force internship program at San Antonio, Texas; Castle Air Force Base, California; and Travis Air Force Base, California.

Ms. Roberts has a Master's Degree in National Resource Strategy from the National Defense University, Industrial College of the Armed Forces, and holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Transportation/Logistics and Marketing from The Ohio State University. She is the recipient of the Achievement Medal for Civilian Service and Government Executive's Travel Manager of the Year Award.
