Nine individual units (see below) were recognized on September 20th at a ceremony hosted by the Transportation Institute and presided over by RADM Mark F. Heinrich, USN, SC, Commander Fleet Industrial & Supply Centers and Forum Co-Moderator.

Simmons, Director, Logistics Plans, Policies, Strategic Mobility Division, U.S. Marine Corps HQ (USMC); RADM Robert O. General Duncan McNabb, USAF, Commander of the the U.S. Transportation Command, the single manager for global air, land, and sea transportation for the Department of Defense, was the special guest and keynote speaker at the 2010 Military Unit Award Ceremony.
