



Submission Guidelines

Thank you for your interest in the Defense Transportation Journal

To help advance understanding of Defense Logistics and Transportation, you are invited to submit ***Feature Articles**, ***Case Studies**, ***Industry Reports** and / or ***Press Releases** to the Defense Transportation Journal (DTJ). Following are brief guidelines for submission:

- We request that information be educational; not advertorial.
- Feature articles range between 1,500 ~ 3,000 words; extensive articles can be published in consecutive issues as Parts I, II.
- Submit your article in Word Document format and without excessive stylistic formatting.
- Material for illustrations (images, charts, and graphics) must be high resolution (300dpi); adobe vector; jpg imaging is preferred.
- Include author(s) Point of Contact details and a short byline that will be printed with the article.
- Submissions may be edited to fit page parameters.
- Proof page layout will be forwarded for review and approval. Depending upon production scheduling, turnaround time may be tight so we request your immediate attention. Nothing will be printed without author(s) confirmation.

A **Feature Article** ("Vision" White Paper) examines a specific technology or process and how its application is of benefit to the Logistics and Transportation Community.

A **Case Study** spotlights real-world examples of implementation, including lessons learned.

An **Industry Report** profiles the specifics of a product, facility, process, achievement or industry leader and is less extensive in content. A **Press Release** is similar, but time sensitive.
