



RAYMOND P. EBELING

Raymond P. Ebeling has been President and Chairman of American Roll-On Roll-Off Carriers (ARC) since 1990. ARC is a U.S. flag liner service ocean carrier which operates eight U.S. Flag Ro-Ro ships between the United States and Northern Europe, and between the U.S. and Mediterranean and Mideast.

Mr. Ebeling is also President and Chairman of American Auto Logistics (AAL), a logistics management firm which manages the worldwide movement of military service member's vehicles for the Department of Defense.

Ray has also been President of Wallenius Lines Holding Inc. (WLHI) since 1990. WLHI manages the U.S. interests of Wallenius Lines of Stockholm, Sweden, a privately held shipping company which owns one of the world's largest Roll-On Roll-Off shipping fleets.

Mr. Ebeling was elected Chairman of the National Defense Transportation Association (NDTA) in September, 2005. NDTA is a trade and educational association comprised of over 8,500 transportation professionals in Defense, Government, and Industry.

Prior to joining the Wallenius Group, Ray held several executive positions at SeaLand Service, including Vice President Marketing and Pricing Atlantic Group. Prior to that, he was Vice President Pricing Asia Division for SeaTrain Lines.

Mr. Ebeling has served on several advisory commissions to the U.S. Government including appointment by President Bush as Commissioner on the Advisory Commission on Conferences in Ocean Shipping.

In 2004, Mr. Ebeling was awarded the Admiral of the Ocean Seas Award (AOTOS), the shipping industry's highest honor, for "distinguished service to American Ships and American Seafarers".

In 2001, Mr. Ebeling was awarded the National Transportation Award by the National Defense Transportation Association (NDTA) "for exemplary contributions to his own industry and the transportation industry at large, in support of national security".

In 2000, Mr. Ebeling was awarded the Herb Brand Award by the Maritime Ports Council for "dedication to a strong and viable American Maritime Industry".

Mr. Ebeling is a native of Framingham, Massachusetts and presently resides in New Jersey with his wife Bonnie. He has received degrees in Economics from Bowdoin College and a Masters in Business Administration from Seattle University.
