Abstract: The Sea Service Deployment Module (SSDM) is a multi-user collaborative ICODES web application that assists the United States Marine Corps, Navy, and Coast Guard in sourcing unit move requirements. This session will include an overview of the SSDM application and how it supports the unit move functions: Unit Deployment List Building, Requesting Transportation, and Preparing Request and Execution Documentation.
